As such, Utopian Academy will participate in virtual learning January 5-7, 2022. All scholars, both elementary and middle school, will return to in-person learning on Monday, January 10, 2022.

Virtual Learning

For interested stakeholders, Utopian Academy for the Arts Middle School will continue to offer a 100% virtual learning option for the spring 2022 semester. All families that elect into this option will be required to complete the virtual learning parent/student contract. COVID Testing

Utopian Academy for the Arts will continue to strictly enforce our COVID mitigation strategies which include mandatory masking, hand sanitization, and surveillance testing. Prior to our winter holiday break, Utopian changed testing vendors to now include testing for both staff and scholars. The need for continuous testing supports our efforts of mitigating the spread with each of our stakeholders. Although testing is not a requirement for our scholars, it is strongly encouraged, and is only authorized by parental/guardian consent. Through research and identified best-practices in local and national schools, surveillance testing has proven to be one of the most impactful strategies in helping to reduce the spread of the virus. Consent forms will be available during onsite drive-thru testing scheduled for next week and additional details will be communicated by your academy principal(s). Additionally, Utopian Academy for the Arts will host two opportunities for COVID-19 drive-thru testing for all faculty, staff, scholars, and parents on Monday, January 3<sup>rd</sup> (10:00am-4:00pm) and Tuesday, January 4<sup>th</sup> (8:00am-4:00pm).
