## **UNIFORM POLICY**

All Utopian Academy Middle School students are required to comply with daily dress codes (see below). Our uniform policy will be enforced daily! Students coming to school out of uniform will be required to call a parent/guardian to bring the missing/improperly worn item. At no time should any aspect of student dress disrupt the learning environment. Students that arrive to school out of uniform will be required to call a parent/guardian to bring the missing item or will be given appropriate clothing to wear. Disciplinary actions will take place for noncompliance of this policy.

**Monday:** Standard uniform

**Tuesday:** Standard uniform

**Wednesday:** Dress For Success (Business casual attire): Students may opt to wear standard uniform instead)

**Thursday:** Standard uniform

**Friday:** Spirit Wear (includes sweatshirt, T-shirt, or hoodie that represents UAFA or a college with uniform bottom)  
(Students may opt to wear standard uniform instead)

Students are required to be in standard uniforms during field trips and other school related activities unless otherwise stated.

The Utopian Academy for the Arts uniform standards are as follows:

**6th Grade Shirts** – Black polo shirt with logo patch or oxford shirt with logo patch (shirts must be tucked)

**6th Grade Bottoms** – khaki pants, shorts, or skirt (which must not be shorter than student’s fingertip)

**Black pants or black jeans** (jeans may be “distressed”, but holes may be **no larger than 3 inches in diameter, patches must cover the holes OR leggings must be worn underneath, NO skin is to show**)

**7th Grade Shirts** – Gray polo shirt with logo patch or oxford shirt with logo patch (shirts must be tucked)

**7th Grade Bottoms** – khaki pants, shorts, or skirt (which must not be shorter than student’s fingertip)

**Black pants or black jeans** (**jeans may be “distressed”, but holes may be no larger than 3 inches in diameter, patches must cover the holes OR leggings must be worn underneath, NO skin is to show**)



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**8th Grade Shirts** – Maroon/burgundy polo shirt with logo patch or oxford shirt with logo patch (shirts must be tucked)

**8th Grade Bottoms** – khaki pants, shorts, or skirt (which must not be shorter than student’s fingertip)

**Black pants or black jeans** (jeans may be “distressed”, but holes may be **no larger than 3 inches in diameter, patches must cover the holes OR leggings must be worn underneath, NO skin is to show**)

**HEADWEAR** - No disruptive headwear. No hats, scarves, nor bandanas of any color.

**KEYCHAINS** - The keychain should be under the shirt or in the pocket completely

**MAKEUP** – If make up is worn, it must be age and school appropriate. There will be NO application in the classrooms.

**UNDERWEAR** - No underclothing (panties, bra, slip, underwear, boxers, or any other item) should ever be visible through any method whether on purpose or accident.

**JEWELRY** – All jewelry should be school appropriate and should not be disruptive to the classroom environment. If administration deems otherwise, student will be required to remove it.

**TATTOOS** (Fake or Real) – Are considered inappropriate and are unacceptable.

**HAIR** - The style is a parenting decision but the inclusion of items into the hair will meet the following restrictions:

The items may not be removed for any length of time during the day as the item will be very secure and if the beads or other small items begin to fall, the student will be asked to remove the rest, place them in a bag and take them home.

If the hair includes any items or symbols that can be interpreted as advocating anything the item will be removed.

Students may not groom themselves in the classrooms. Grooming must take place in designated areas at designated times. Hairbrushes, combs, and other items used outside of the restroom will be confiscated.
