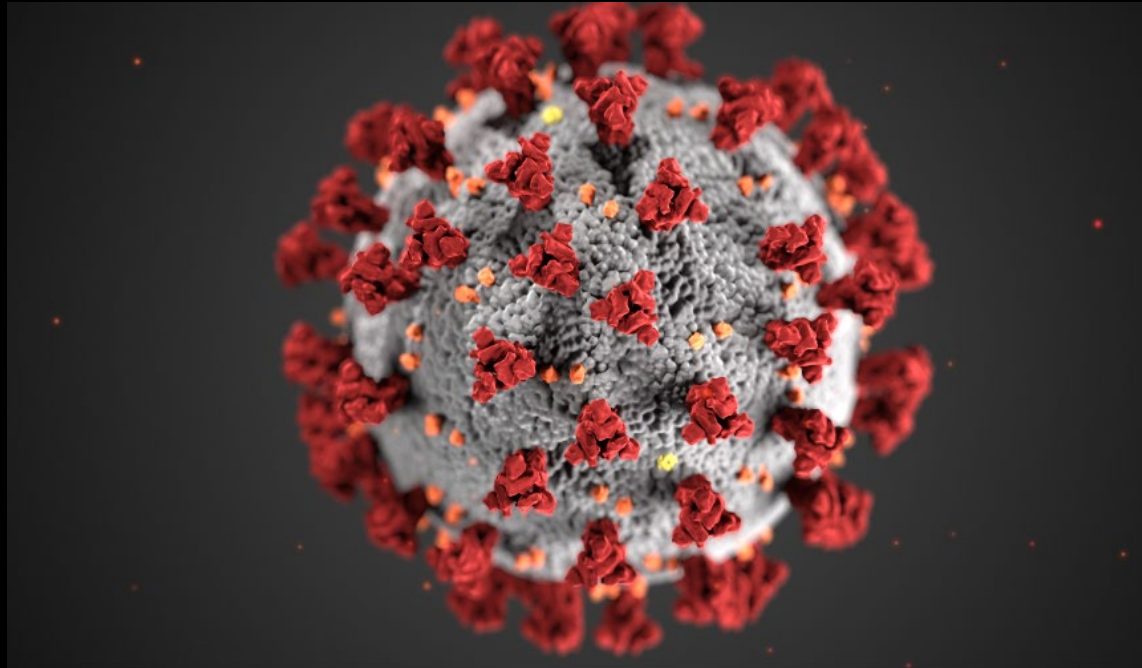


What is SARS-COV₂

SARS-COV2 IS THE SCIENTIFIC NAME FOR COVID-19.
FIRST DISCOVERED IN DECEMBER OF 2019, IT IS A
COMBINATION OF SARS(SEVERE ACUTE RESPIRATORY
SYNDROME) AND CORONAVIRUS 2.



What's the difference between COVID-19 and the Variants?

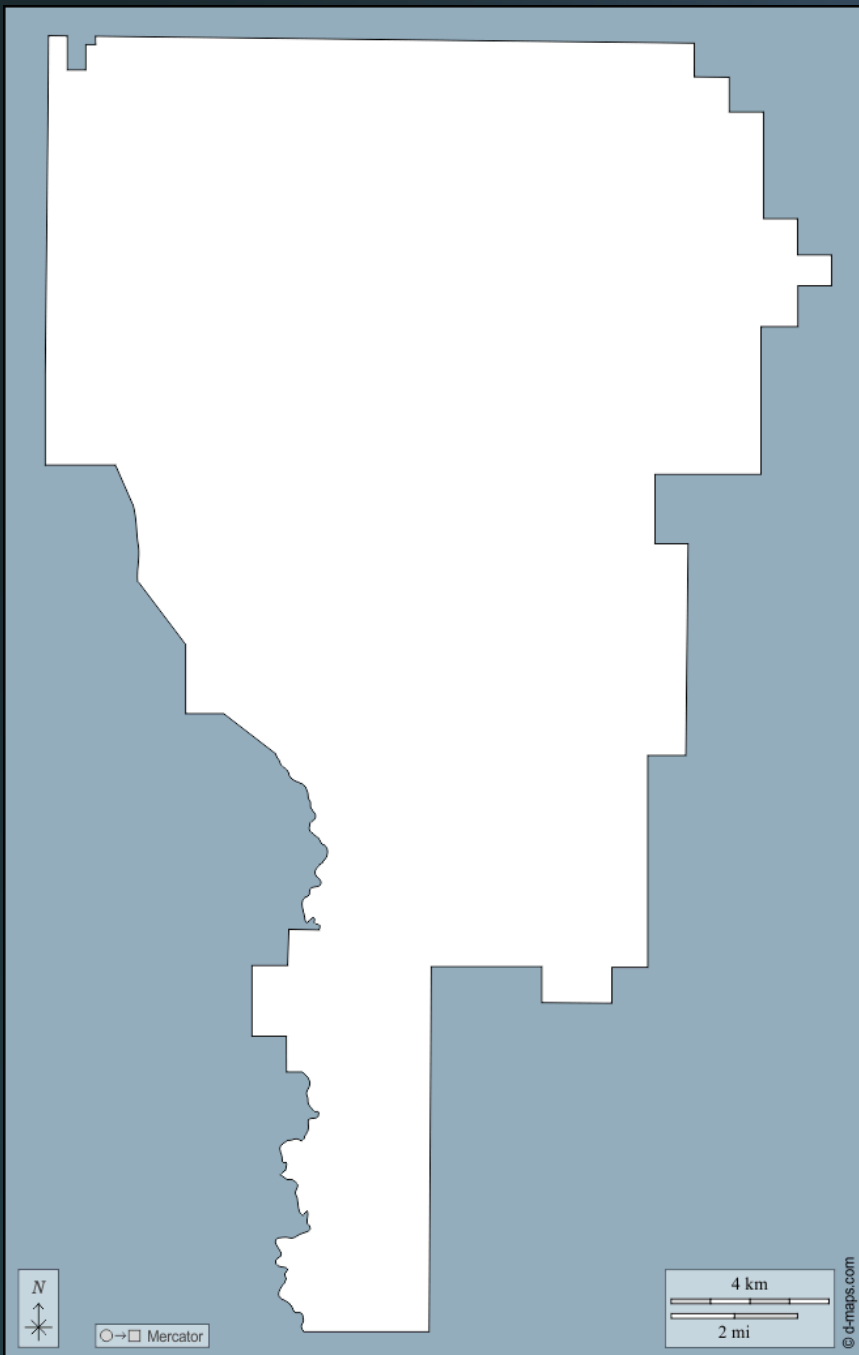
It's easiest to think of COVID-19 as a tree. Each new variant is a branch on the tree and every sub-variant is a twig or leaf on that branch.





The best protection against COVID-19 is the vaccine.

The vaccines offer the best protection from serious illness and/or death from COVID-19. Vaccines have been approved for use for ages 5 to adults. All children and adults are recommended to get vaccinated including those who have already had COVID-19.



As of August 7, 2022, the number of fully vaccinated residents has finally reached 50%.

Knowing the numbers in Clayton County:

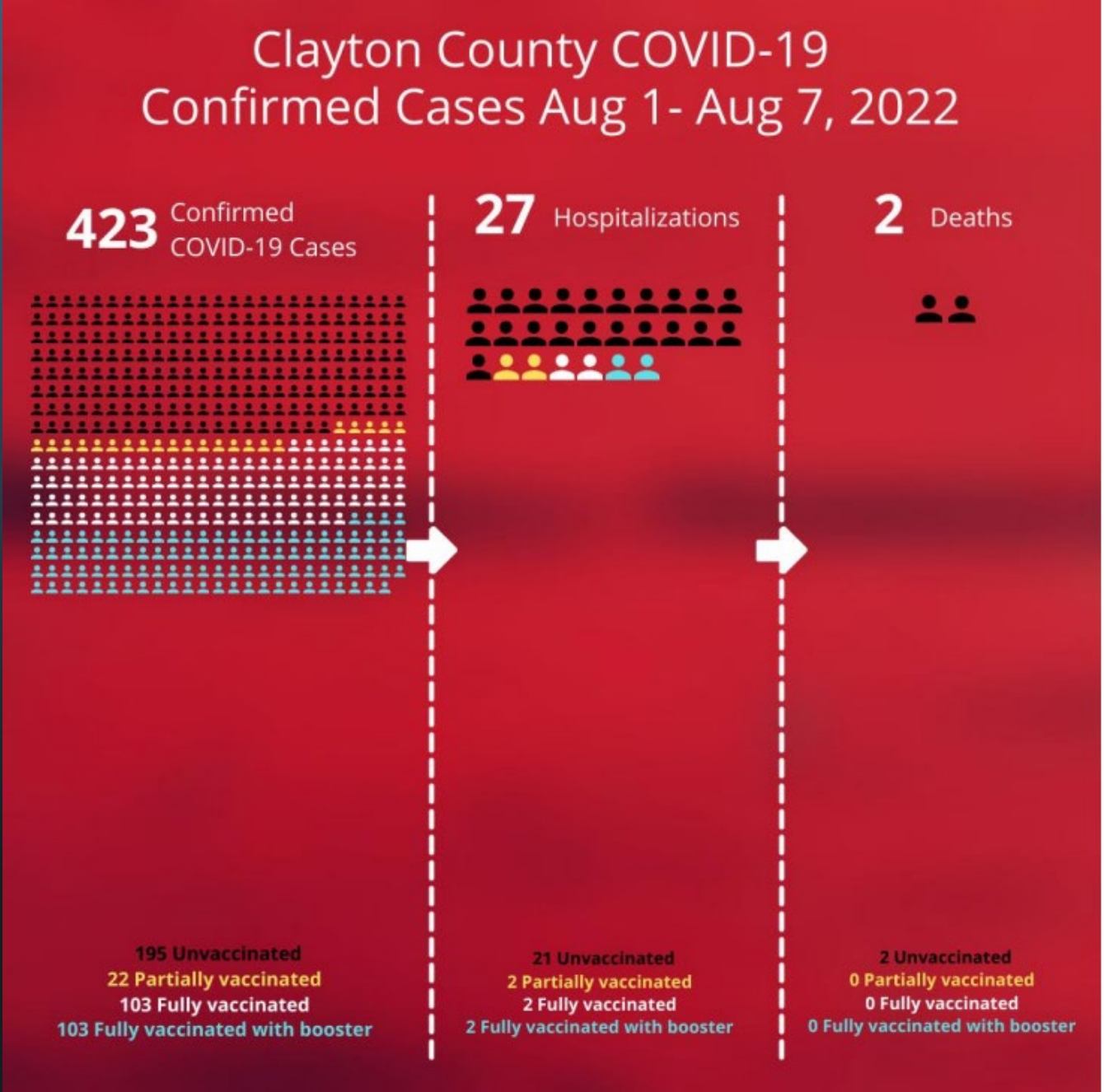
55% of residents have received one (1) dose of the vaccine.

50% of residents have received two (2) doses of the vaccine.

40% of residents have received a booster. That number is just over 56,000.

20% of residents have received an additional booster or 4th shot.

What is Utopian Academy doing to protect its community?

- All Desks will be wiped down twice daily.

Will my scholar have to wear a mask at school?

In compliance with the "Unmask Georgia Students" Law, parents/guardians will be provided an "Opt-out" form to allow your school to be unmasked while at school.

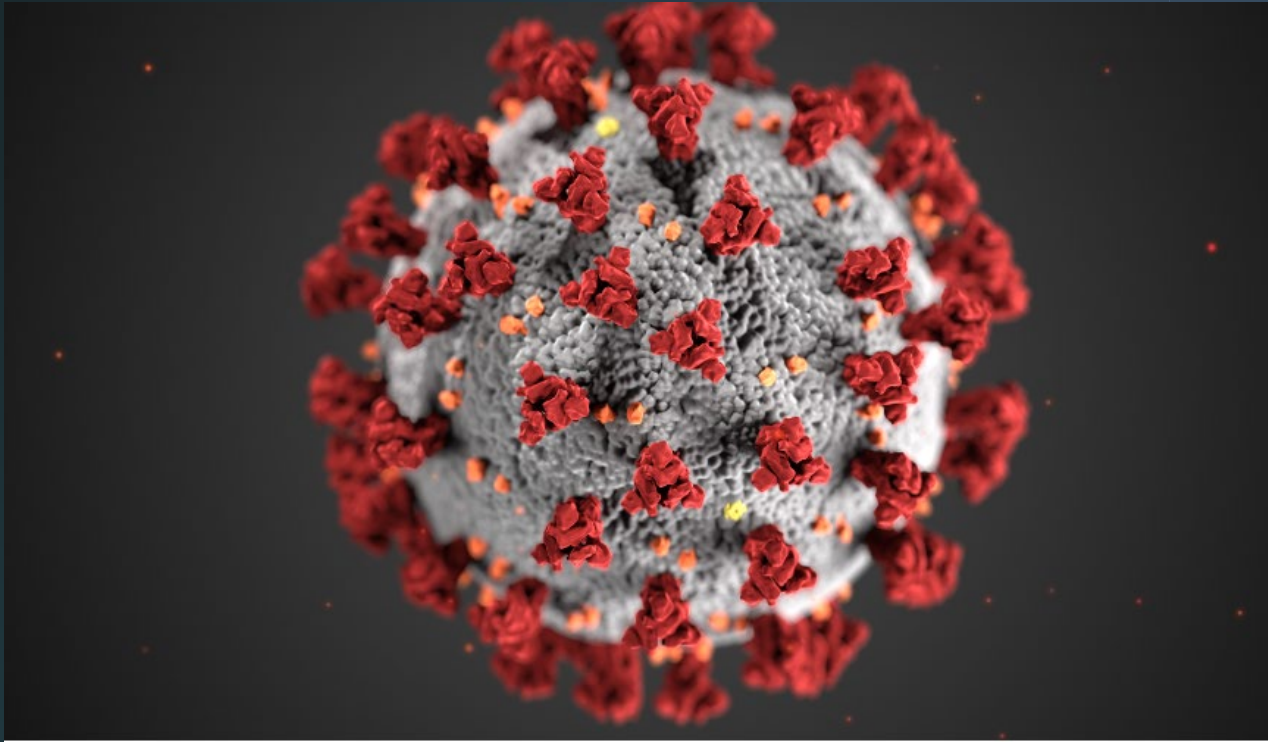

well, what
should you do?

COVID-19 symptoms are many and varied. If your child is not feeling well or displaying symptoms of **ANY** kind, we ask that you keep them home and monitor their health. Consult a Doctor if you need to do so. If your child has been tested for COVID-19 during a Doctor's visit, please **do not** send them to school until you receive a negative result from the Doctor.
