Position Overview

The Dean of Culture at Utopian Academy for the Arts High School plays a pivotal role in fostering a positive and inclusive school culture that supports the academic, social, and emotional growth of students. This leadership position is responsible for developing, implementing, and overseeing programs and initiatives that promote a safe, respectful, and nurturing learning environment. At Utopian Academy for the Arts High School, we believe that students will rise to meet the high expectations set by our team of educators. **This position reports directly to the High School Principal.**

Key Responsibilities

- Develop and implement strategies to create a positive and inclusive school culture that aligns with the values and mission of the charter school.
- Prepare regular reports for school leadership on culture-related metrics and trends.
- Foster a sense of belonging and community among students, staff, and families.
- Design and implement a comprehensive behavior management system that focuses on restorative practices, positive reinforcement, and character development.
- Work collaboratively with teachers, staff, and parents to address and resolve behavioral issues in a fair and consistent manner.
- Develop and oversee SEL programs to support the emotional well-being of students.
- Collaborate with teachers to integrate SEL practices into the curriculum and daily school routines.
- Collaborate with parents, guardians, and community members to build a strong support network for students.
- Organize and participate in community events that promote a sense of unity and shared responsibility for student success.
- Provide training and support for teachers and staff on fostering a positive and inclusive classroom environment.
- Stay current on best practices in school culture and share relevant information with the school community.
- Act as a mediator in resolving conflicts among students, staff, and parents.
- Implement conflict resolution strategies that promote understanding and cooperation.
- Utilize data to assess the effectiveness of culture-related initiatives and make data-driven decisions for continuous improvement.
- Perform other duties as assigned by an appropriate administrator or their representative.
