- Teach mathematical concepts and principles through hands-on exploration, real-world applications, and inquiry-based learning experiences that promote deep understanding and mathematical reasoning.
- Provide instruction in mathematical skills and procedures, including arithmetic operations, algebraic expressions, geometry concepts, and statistical analysis, using various instructional strategies and resources.
